ALUMNI REUNION POLICY & GUIDELINES

Background

Section 4 of the Tocal Alumni Constitution states the following:

4 OBJECTS

- 4.1 To foster, support, and promote a State, National, and International network for students, staff, members of the community, and others with an interest or link to Tocal.
- 4.2 To establish and maintain a database of all members of the Alumni.
- 4.3 To advance the growth of community and industry support by communicating the benefits of ongoing association with Tocal.
- 4.4 To participate in, contribute to, and advance the community and culture of Tocal, through:
 - I. Promotion and support of Tocal events
 - II. Fundraising for special projects and/or scholarships
 - III. Promoting the opportunities to support Tocal

One strategy to achieve these objectives is for the Tocal Alumni Committee to develop and implement a policy and set of guidelines for reunions with the aim of achieving consistently positive outcomes for the Alumni and the College.



ALUMNI REUNION POLICY & GUIDELINES

Background

Ex-students will primarily attend reunions to renew friendships made while at college, however, involvement will also enrich their affinity with the College. This will bring long-term benefits to the Alumni and the College.

The Alumni Committee agreed that the reunion policy and guidelines will address the following:

- Proactive organisation of reunions based on 50th anniversary of graduation.
- Support any year group who wishes to visit Tocal and/or have a reunion at a location other than Tocal.
- Work towards Foundation Day being the annual focus for ex-students to return to the College.
- All advertising of reunions to be in accordance with current community standards so as not to reflect negatively on the Alumni and the College.



50-YEAR REUNIONS

Each 50-year reunion can be held over the year, preference is the second or third weekend of September

The *base itinerary* for each reunion is:

- Arrival at Tocal College accommodation (Glendarra) Friday afternoon.
- Dinner organised externally by cohort. Alumni Officer can provide suggestions.
- Saturday - Guided homestead (depending on Wedding bookings) and/or Tocal farm tours (depending on staff) or tours around the local area, such as Dungog Picnic Train. All tours are an additional cost.
- Breakfast and lunch are provided at Tocal College Dining Hall.
- Dinner Saturday evening – the main event.
 - Special Tocal Alumni guests, such as Tocal Alumni Committee members and Principal Darren Bayley to attend (Alumni Officer by request).
 - Dinner is held at the Glendarra accommodation. Dining options; banquet or self-facilitated BBQ cooked by cohort.
- Sunday – departure, option to visit Tocal Homestead as their Visitor Centre is open 10 am – 3pm.

Please book as early as possible, as the Tocal site has been in high demand and weekend bookings fill up quickly.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Alumni Officer

- The Tocal Alumni Officer can advertise a call for members from that year on various mediums, as well as contact all those on the database for the year.
- Work alongside a contact in the cohort to run information by.
- Help support the organization of an itinerary and distribution.
- Be available for any assistance for the duration of the reunion.
- Provide images and historical artifacts from the year the cohort attended.

The College & Tocal Bookings Team (Reception)

- Book in all accommodation, meals, and tour guides
- Provide a tour guide for Tocal Homestead and Tocal Farms tours
- Provide Glendarra 2 Conference Room for the reunion activities

The Cohort

- It is expected that where possible year groups will provide other contact details for members of their year that may not be on the Tocal Alumni database; Potentiality.
- Year groups will nominate a group leader to help facilitate the arrangement of the reunion in order for cohesion between the Alumni Officer/College and cohort.
- Cohort to decide if they would rather have a more formal banquet dinner or a self-facilitated BBQ .
- In good faith, provide the Tocal Alumni with a donation. This donation supports the operation of the Alumni.

Traditionally a donation of \$10 per student, but this is up to the cohort's discretion.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation at Tocal

Tocal's excellent accommodation, catering, education, and meeting facilities make it an ideal venue for reunions, conferences, seminars, and training. The Campus is located in a tranquil rural setting 3 km from the Paterson township and 18 km from Maitland, within easy reach of the attractions of the Hunter Valley.

Types of accommodation

Glendarra

Glendarra accommodation is located across the road from the College campus in a quiet rural setting and is in motel style rooms. The rooms have views across the paddocks and are equipped with tea and coffee making facilities, bar fridges as well as access to a common room.



Glendarra 2 accommodation at Tocal can cater to different group sizes. Five rooms contain a king bed and a single. Six rooms contain a queen bed and a single. Two rooms contain 3 single beds. Two rooms contain 2 single beds and a double bunk. The complex also contains a conference room with a fridge, microwave, and sink area, perfect for corporates, craft groups, and team-building exercises. There is one room that is accessible by wheelchair.

There are also 11 rooms available in Glendarra 1; all are single rooms with ensuite. Available for use is a common room with a television and kitchenette containing a fridge, stove, and sink.

ACCOMMODATION

Types of accommodation

Cottages and flats

The College campus also provides [flats and cottages](#) should you have a larger group you need to accommodate for. These are located on the College campus adjacent to the main entrance.



The two flats contain two single beds, a bar fridge, bathroom, and television while the two cottages provide up to ten single beds in each. The cottages have small kitchens and a lounge room.

Student rooms

There are 90 [student rooms](#) on campus. For the majority of the year these rooms are fully booked to the students though may be available to groups during College holidays. They are single rooms and contain no facilities. There is two shower/toilet blocks located at either end of the student area and a self-service laundry.

ACCOMMODATION

The Barracks, Tocal

Situated on one of Australia's oldest colonial working farms, [The Barracks](#) provides boutique accommodation on a unique heritage site.

Four suites have been beautifully restored to provide elegant comforts in the same space where convicts and farmhands worked and toiled over 150 years ago.

Each suite allows guests to enjoy the same views of sweeping hillsides and colonial buildings in air-conditioned comfort.

For those cool evenings, at the push of a button, a restored fireplace is available to warm the sitting room. The sitting room, kitchenette and bathroom are downstairs while upstairs are the sleeping quarters. Queen sized beds are in three of the suites with one suite providing two king sized single beds. Tea and coffee making facilities are available in each little kitchenette with a Nespresso machine, kettle, toaster and a bar fridge provided.

A breakfast hamper consisting of fresh and wholesome breakfast foods sourced from our local area is complimentary and delivered to your suite each morning of your stay.

Enjoy a cup of tea outside on the verandah while watching the farm animals graze nearby. The Barracks are not suitable for children under the age of 13. [Book directly online here.](#)

Paterson & Surrounds

Kings ND Queens

COLLEGE FACILITIES

Tocal is situated on 2,200 hectares, so our facilities offer groups plenty of space. The Glendarra conference room is ideal for groups that require accommodation to be close, while the College offers other room sizes and facilities based on your needs.

Large Group Facilities at Tocal

EA Hunt Hall

Capacity – 300 - 500

The hall is almost 30 m long and 18.2 m wide which makes it perfect for large functions and ceremonies. There are 30 oblong tables and 400 chairs available to use. Theatre style the hall will seat up to 700 people comfortably.



Hay Shed Function Centre

Capacity – 140 - 250

The [Hayshed Function Centre](#) is a great place for functions and conferences commanding a magnificent view over the lagoon whilst you take in the unique character of the building.



The Function centre has plenty of space including a mezzanine area. Groups can enjoy a catered morning tea or lunch under the iconic fig trees or in a rustic barn. Catering is provided by [Sprout catering](#) where all day, half day, breakfast, lunch, dinner or BBQ buffet lunches are available.

Large Group Facilities at Tocal

Chapel

Capacity – 200

North Court 3

Tocal Library

Additional Facilities

All our groups that book accommodation and stay onsite are invited to use our onsite facilities including the community pool (open during the September - April months), tennis courts and BBQ areas.



Tocal Catering

The Tocal College kitchen provides healthy, nutritious food for students and staff as well as providing event catering for the many visitor groups and functions at the College.



They can cater for special diets and food requests and make fresh deliveries to your meeting room or cater for you in our Dining Hall.

As with many other College facilities, use of the Dining Hall is coordinated around the students and mealtimes are at set times. Meals taken in the dining hall are cafeteria-style and follow the menu set for the students and will usually include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

- Continental breakfast
- Lunch - Choice of two dishes
- Dinner - Choice of two dishes plus dessert

Morning and afternoon teas can be catered for in the Dining Hall as well.

SAMPLE REUNION ITINERARY

Saturday

Morning:

- Arrival of guests at the College grounds, checking into accommodation.
- Meet at Glendarra Conference Room 2. Self-catered or Tocal catered morning tea available OR grazing boxes available from [Paterson Pantry](#).

Lunch:

- Optional farm tours around the College, subject to staff availability.
- Tours of local businesses and surrounds, such as Hunter Valley Gardens, wineries, John Tucker Park
- Lunch available at Tocal Dining Hall or self-catered. OR adventure out into the local region.

Dinner:

- Dinner is available at Tocal Dining Hall or cook your own at the BBQ outside Glendarra. You can bring the food yourself or Tocal can provide a selection of meats and salads.
- Hold reunion party in Glendarra Conference Room 2.
- Alcohol is allowed on Glendarra facility, but not allowed near student campus. Alcohol is not available to drink at Tocal Dining Hall.
- We hope to organise a special Alumni guest and/or Tocal principal, Darren Bayley, or staff to attend the reunion gathering.

SAMPLE REUNION ITINERARY

Sunday

Morning:

- Self-catered breakfast at Glendarra Conference Room 2 or order breakfast at Tocal Dining Hall.

Lunch:

- Tour of Tocal Homestead, this historical site covers more than 140 acres of open land. You can book a two-hour guided tour of the heritage site which showcases the stories of the characters and activities at Tocal over the past 200 years. This tour is available during the week and on weekends.

A self-guided tour is available when the visitor centre is open (March–November from 10 am–3 pm)

PLANNING TIPS & TRICKS

Tips on how to make planning your reunion easier:

- Best to contact your cohort first and start working on a date. Once you have a date and know how many people, please contact Tocal bookings to see availabilities.
- You can put rooms on hold with Tocal bookings and people from your cohort can ring up to utilize these rooms. To pay for your rooms, you can get people to book and pay directly as a deposit will be required. Sometimes, one person nominates themselves puts down a deposit, pays for the rooms, and then collects the payments from everyone. This streamlines the booking process.
- Within your cohort, allocate one individual who is the main contact. They are responsible for organising the group lists of who is attending, catering numbers and dietary requests, and accommodation lists. These lists are helpful information to pass on to the College bookings team and our Alumni Officer so we can help allocate rooms. The individual can delegate the tasks out to other people, but they should collect the information and return it to Tocal from one contact.
- Have fun, the college has a range of events occurring throughout the year, and you can organise a reunion around them.

TOTAL CATERING Menu 2024

We offer you a range of convenient catering options to suit your needs. You can choose from the different selections listed to create your own event menu. If you would like to have something that you do not see here, feel free to contact us to discuss some options. We are very happy to work with you to tailor a menu and catering service to your needs. The following menus are a guide and subject to changes or seasonal variations.



Gluten-free and other dietary requirements:

Tocal is happy to cater to your specific dietary requirements. Some dietary requirements may incur an additional surcharge of \$5 per meal. Please call us to discuss your specific requirements.

Traditional Sandwich lunch - \$15 per head – minimum 5 people

One and a half sandwiches per person (6 points). Prepared on white and multigrain breads with a variety of fillings including:

- Egg, lettuce, tomato, mayo
- Roast beef and pesto
- Chicken, mayo, lettuce
- Ham, cheese, tomato, mustard pickle
- Salad
- Silverside and pickles.

Wraps Lunch - \$15 per head – minimum 5 people

One wrap per person, price and fillings as per sandwich menu.

Wrap and Sandwich Combo - \$15 per head – minimum 5 people

1/2 wrap and 3 sandwich points per person, price and fillings as per sandwich menu. Minimum 5 people for wrap and sandwich combo.

All sandwich/wrap lunches include a seasonal fruit platter.

Juice is available at additional cost of \$6 – 2L Bottle.

Hot Finger Food - \$19 per head – minimum 5 people ¹

4 pieces per person, plus 1/2 sandwich (2 points). It will be a combination of the following items.

- Spinach and feta filo triangles
- Variety of mini quiches (Lorraine, spinach and feta, zucchini and sun-dried tomato)
- Moroccan meatballs
- Selection of gourmet mini pies
- Chicken wing things
- Crumbed prawn cutlets
- Vegetarian spring rolls.

Finger food meal is combined with mixed sandwiches and includes a seasonal fruit platter.

Lunch in the Dining Room - \$15 per head

Lunch can be taken in the comfort of our dining room.

Buffet style lunch, set menu, usually consists of the choice of two hot dishes. Set times and bookings essential.

Dinner in Dining Room - \$19 per head

Dinner can be taken in the comfort of our dining room .

Buffet style dinner, set menu, usually consists of the choice of two hot dishes and dessert. Set times and bookings essential.

Self-Cooked BBQ Lunch or Dinner - \$19 per head – minimum 5 people

Packed to take away—you cook.

- 1 piece steak and 2 sausages per person
- 2 salads (assorted) and onion
- 1 bread roll each, sauces and utensils.

Lunch BBQ includes a seasonal fruit platter.

Dinner BBQ includes dessert.

Self-Cooked BBQ Breakfast - \$15 per head – minimum 5 people

Packed to take away—you cook.

- Bacon, eggs, mushrooms, tomato.
- Toast, butter, sauces and utensils.

Morning Tea and Afternoon Tea - \$6 per head – minimum 5 people

- Includes tea and coffee.
- Assorted sweet cakes, slices, and biscuits (subject to availability).

Savoury Afternoon Tea - \$6 per head - minimum 5 people

- Assorted savoury muffins, croissants, quiche (subject to availability).

Cheese and Crackers Platter - \$30 – suitable for 5 people

- Cheese, cabanossi, served with dried fruits and crackers.

Breakfast in the Dining Hall - \$15 per head

- Continental and hot breakfast available Monday to Sunday.

Please read these terms and conditions before making your booking



Bookings

- Approximate catering numbers to be given at time of booking, preferably one week in advance, particularly for large groups.
- Changes to orders to be communicated no later than 48 hours before the event.
- Final numbers to be confirmed no later than 48 hours before event or function. You will be charged for the number booked, or the number present, whichever is greater.

Delivery

- Delivery can be arranged at specific times and only locations within Tocal College and immediate area.

Payment

- For bookings over \$500, a 50% deposit is required with booking. The balance is payable on delivery of your order, unless earlier arrangements have been made.
- Cash, approved company cheques and credit card payments are accepted.
- Pre-approved clients can be invoiced.

Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations must be received no later than 48 hours before delivery or a 50% cancellation fee may be incurred.
- Orders cancelled within 24 hours of delivery will need to be paid in full given the cost of stock purchased and staff engaged to prepare the order.

PPE/Urns/Plungers/Serving Utensils

- PPE will be provided for a designated person to serve individual portions of food. The PPE must be worn at all times while serving and handling food.
- Urns and serving utensils are to be returned or left in the rooms after your event.
- You will be billed for any lost/misplaced items.

Cleaning of conference rooms

- Please place crockery and cutlery in dishwasher (if they are fitted in your room) and start eco wash cycle.

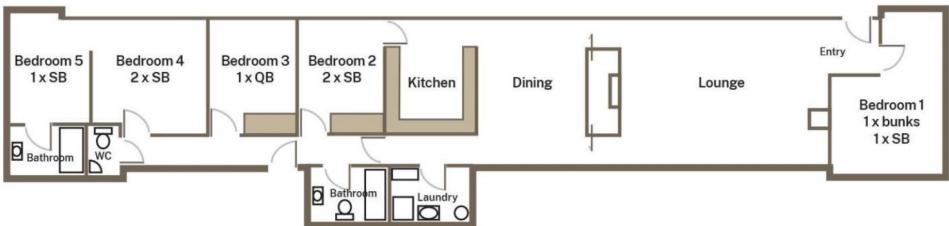

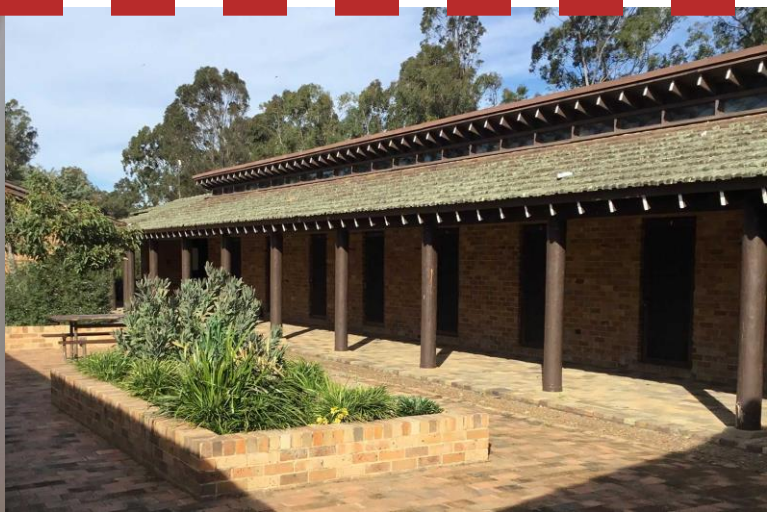

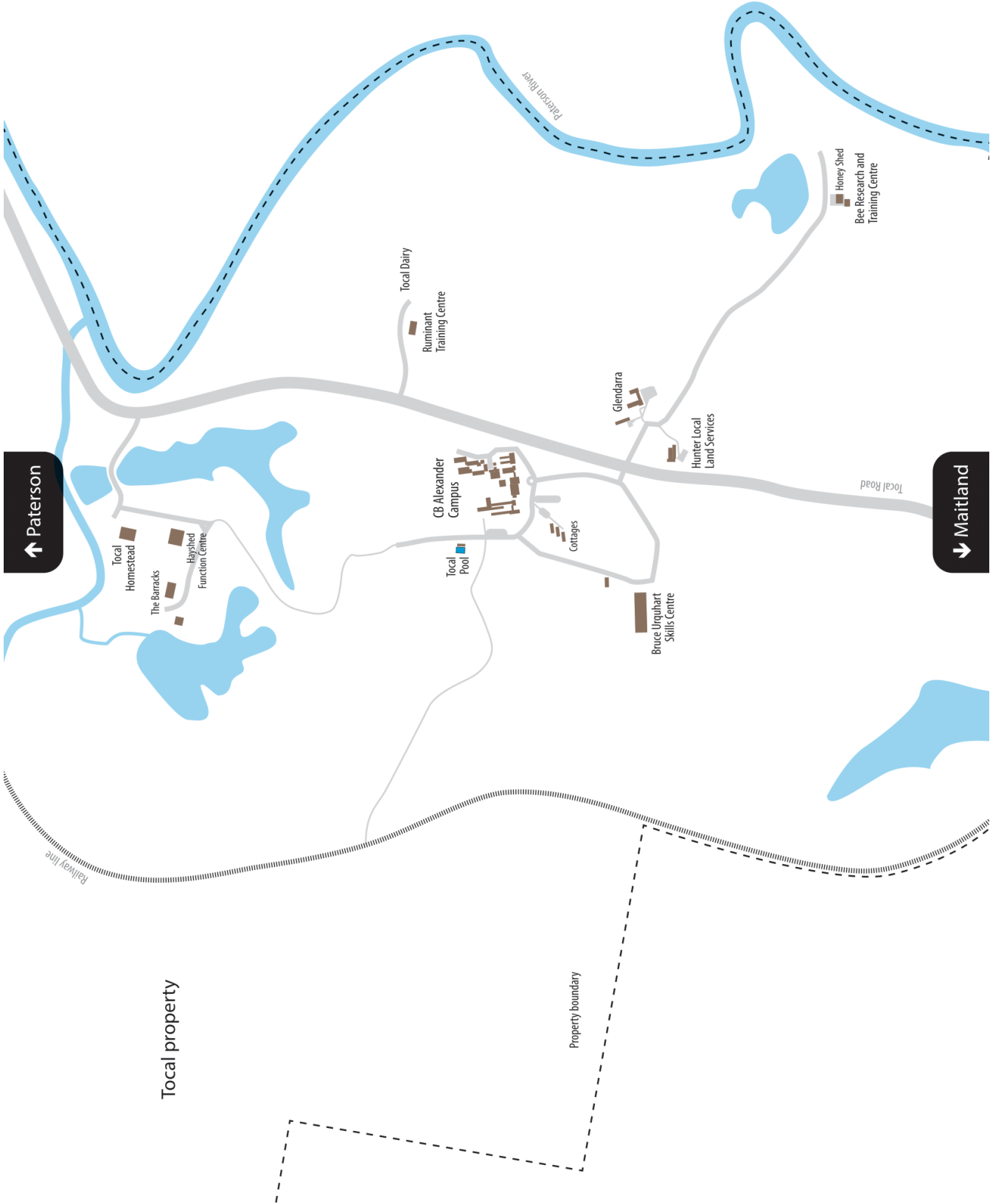

MAP OF TOCAL, PATERSON NSW

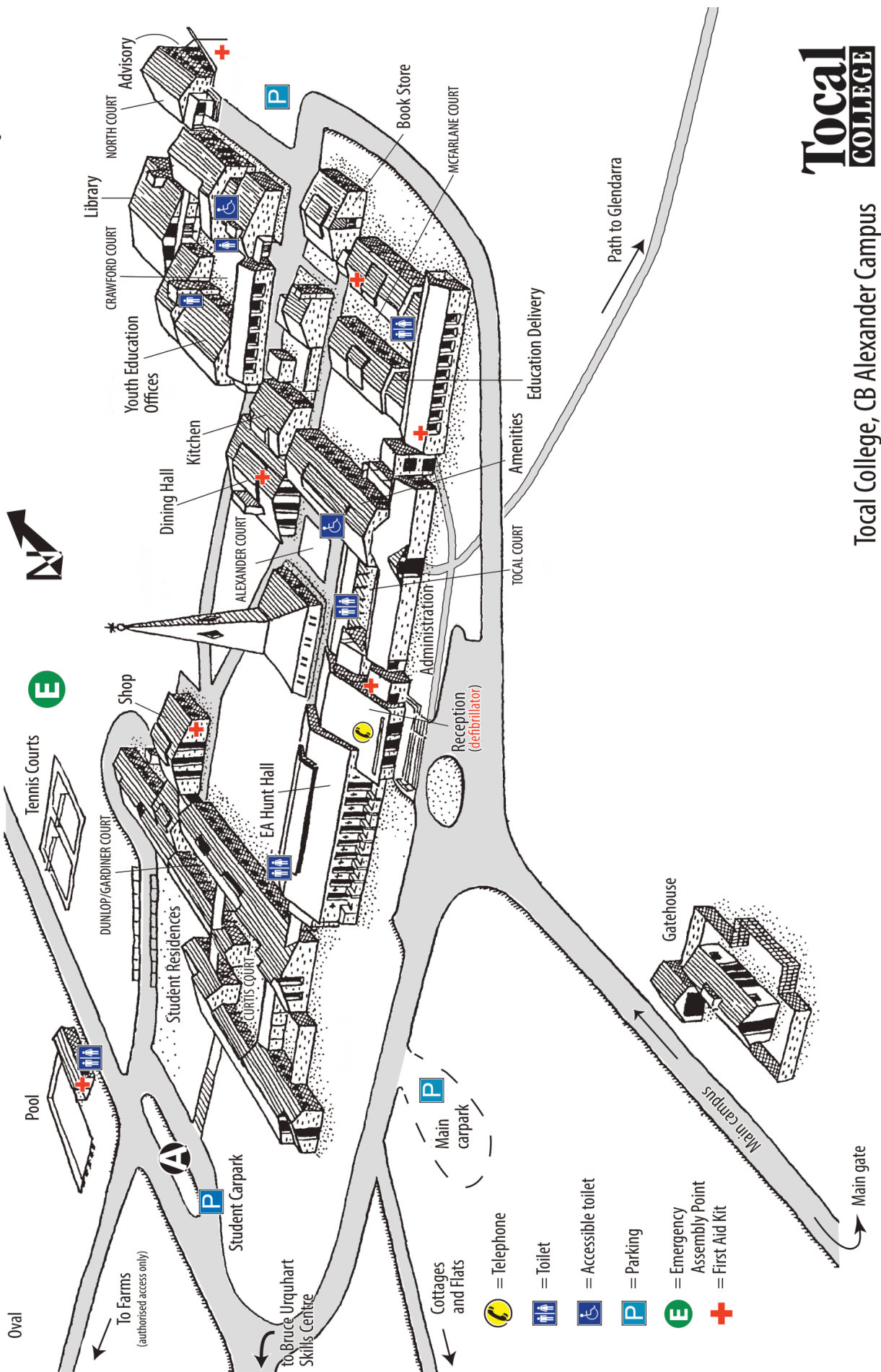

TOTAL CAMPUS MAP

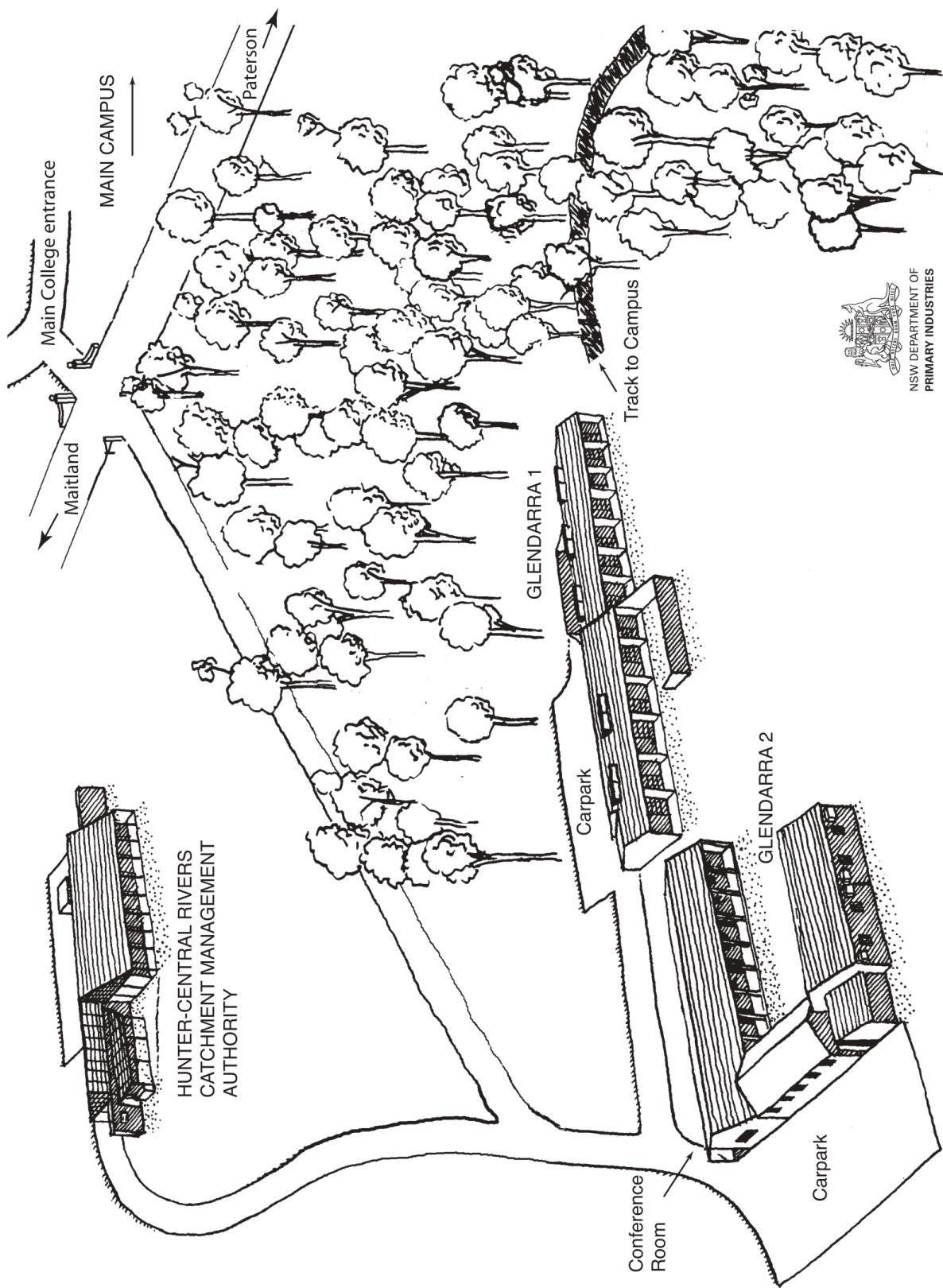

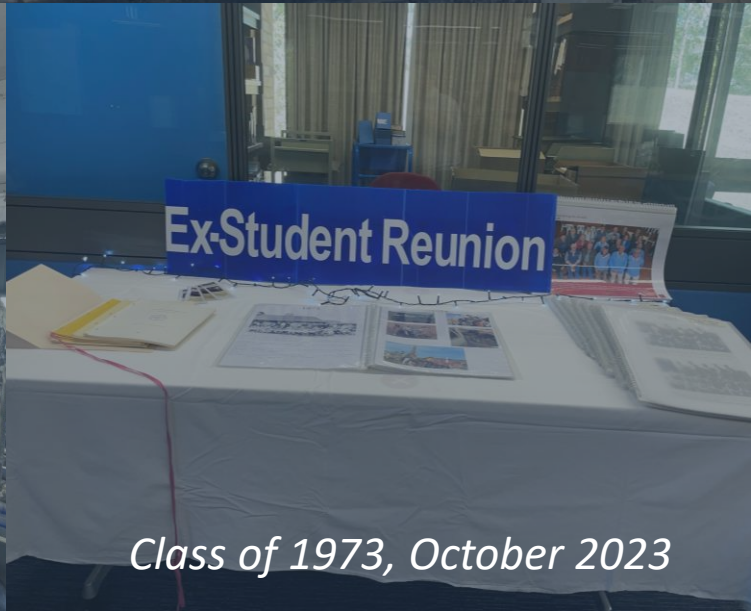
